### Decimals

Work out what we need to make a whole  
Write and partition decimals  
Compare and order decimals  
Round decimals to the nearest whole number  
Learn the decimal equivalents of fractions such as  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$  and  $\frac{3}{4}$

### Money

Write money in pounds and pence, using a decimal point  
Order, add and subtract amounts of money  
Make estimates with money  
Find change  
Solve simple word problems involving money

### Time

Convert between units of time  
Write times in different ways  
Compare times by converting units  
Solve problems involving units of time
