
Friendly Reminders

What we are studying

Maths

We will begin our term with learning about length and comparing different units of measure. We will also learn what perimeter is and how to calculate it for different shapes.

We will then focus on fractions. We will learn how to find fractions of amount, what a fraction is, comparing and ordering fractions and some equivalent fractions.

We will be continuing to focus on and learn our 4,8 and 3 times tables.

English

In English, we will be learning how to write informal letters.

We will use the book 'Meerkat Mail' to support us in doing this.

We will then be working on our debating skills and looking at how to articulate an opinion and give a counter opinion

Our class novel this term will be 'The Butterfly Lion' by Michael Morpurgo.



The book follows the story of a boy called Bertie who saves a lion cub whilst living on the plains of Africa.

Geography

Our main focus this term will be Geography.

We will be learning about the different biomes all over the world and linking these to climate zones.

We will think about the plants that grow in each of these biomes and focus on which biomes that are found within the continent of Africa.



Other areas of the curriculum

- In Computing, we will use the computers to research and find out more about African Animals.
- We will also be creating moving/pop up Easter cards using pneumatics in our DT lessons.
- The children will be learning about Easter during their RE lessons.
- During our Science lessons, we will look at animals and their bones. We will explore how different animals have different bones and the importance of our bones. Also, we will look at how our muscles and joints work in order to help us to move.
- In PSHE, we will be looking at keeping healthy and how to lead a healthy and balanced lifestyle based on the foods we need to eat and exercise.
