## What we are studying

#### **Maths**

In Maths, we will be focusing heavily on addition and subtraction – eventually challenging ourselves to add and subtract 2 digit numbers. We will also be continuing to work on our x10, x2 and x5 times tables. Homework for maths will be set weekly on Purple Mash and there will also be homework set on TT Rockstars.

## **English**

During our English this term, we will continue to develop the children's understanding of the Year 2 grammar objectives. We will also continue to look at spelling rules and exceptions.

Our English topic is looking at poetry. We will look at poems about fire to link in with our History topic. We will also read our class novel 'Toby and The Great Fire of London' and use it to help us to write our own narrative.

## History

This term, our theme is based around our History unit which is all about The Great Fire of London. We will be learning about how the fire started, why it spread and what happened after the fire.

Key vocabulary- fire, London, baker, spread, squirt, wooden, timber, King Charles, narrow, fire engine, leather buckets, Samuel Pepys, diary, The Monument, Pudding Lane, Thomas Farriner, bakery



### Science and DT

Our Science is all about materials and their properties. We will be doing some experiments and continuing our work on improving our scientific skills. In our DT lessons we will be tasting bread, making salt dough and eventually making our own bread!
