Final Arrangements for the Reception Nativity Performance on the afternoon of Monday 18th December at 2.15pm

- The performance will take place in the main school hall and start at 2.15pm.
- Doors will be opened at 2.00pm.
- You can enter school via the gate on Durham road, through the door near the kitchen / minibus.
- All Reception pupils will take part in this performance.
- After the performance, pupils will return to the Reception unit and can be collected as normal at the end
 of the day.

Final arrangements for the Reception Nativity Performance on the evening of Tuesday 19th December - 6.00pm

- The performance will take place in the main school hall and start at 6pm.
- Doors will be opened at 5.30pm for drop off and children should be back at school no later than 5.50pm
- Parking will be available on the school yard. Entrance into school from the yard will be via the Year 6 door in the corner near the hall.
- You can also enter school via the gate on Durham road, through the door near the kitchen / minibus.
- All Reception pupils will meet in the school gym.
- Your child will get changed into their costume at school, so should come wearing their school uniform.
- · Your child should wear their school shoes on their feet
- Due to the volume of children, once you drop off your child in the gym please keep hold of their coat.
- If you are not able to stay for the evening performance, you must return to school to collect your child at 6.30pm
