From September 2026, there will be a small increase to the cost of our After School Club and school meals. After School Club will increase from £8.50 to £9.00 per day, and school dinners will increase from £2.50 to £2.60 per meal. We have worked hard to keep these increases to a minimum, however, rising staffing, food and energy costs mean that a small adjustment is necessary. 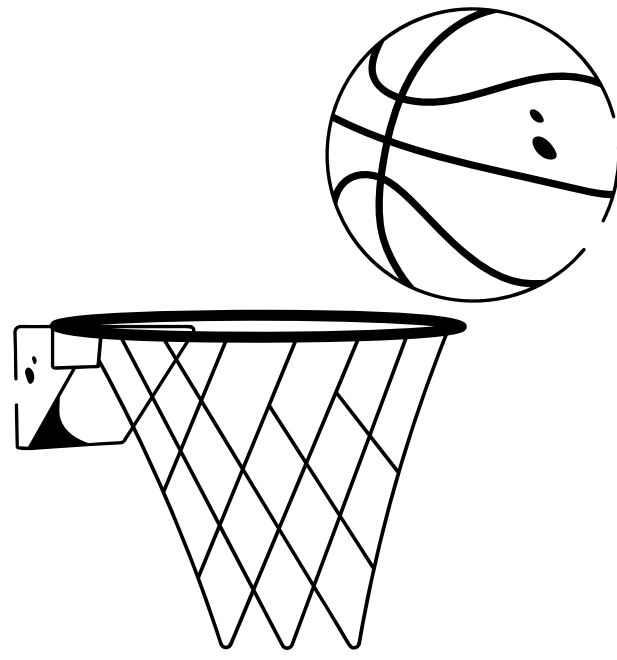

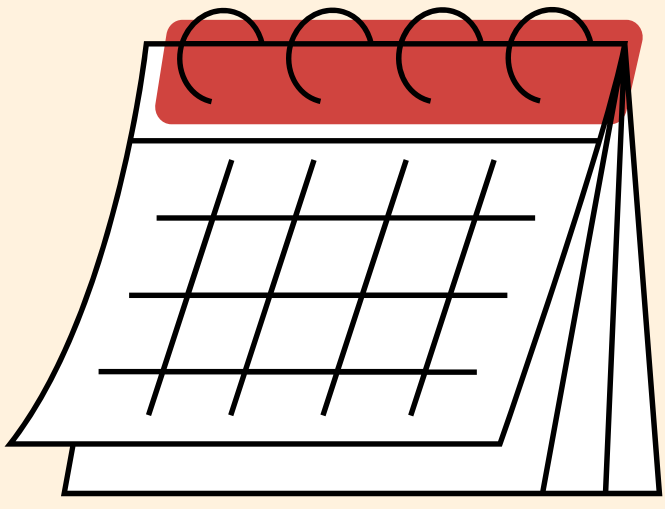
GARDENING CLUB



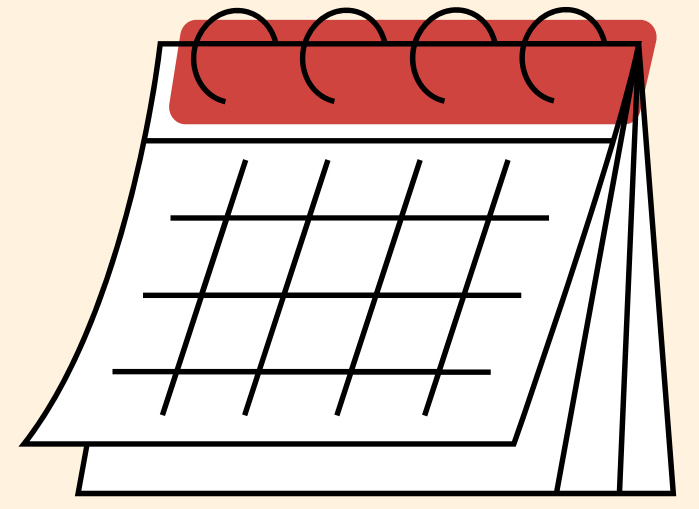
This week at gardening club the children planted pumpkin seeds, so hope they will be ready for Halloween. Hopefully if we grow enough we will sell some of the plants later on.

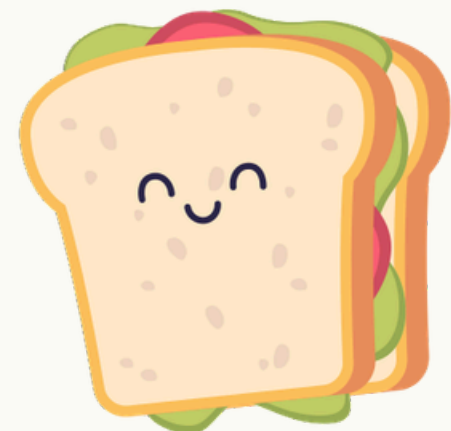

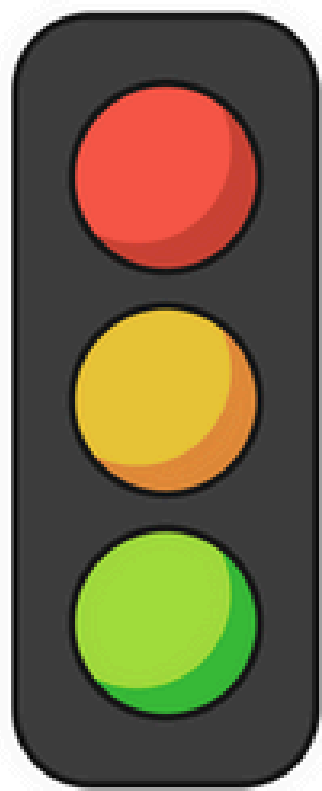
