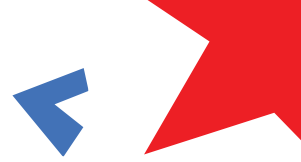
Dates for your Diary

Friendly Reminders

- **Reading** – Please ensure that your child has their reading book in school at all times and that they read 5 times a week at home.
- Forest School** will take place this half term for 1S on Tuesday afternoons and for 1N on Thursday afternoons – with the exception of week beginning 8th June, where 1N will take part in their first forest school on Friday 12th June due to sports day. The children will be going into Sunnyhurst Woods and most probably getting wet and dirty! Children will need to bring suitable clothes to get changed into including waterproofs and wellies/walking boots/ old footwear. Spare socks/ underwear is also handy to send in too!

English and Maths

In English, we will continue to work on the children's writing skills. The children will get the opportunity to write both fiction and non-fiction pieces. In Maths, we will be covering fractions, position and direction, numbers to 100, money and time. Please continue to practise x2 and x5 times table facts with your children at home, as well as number facts to 10 and 20. The game 'Hit the Button' is a good one online to help with these. It would also be useful to work on learning and recognising numbers to 100.

Foundation Subjects

This half term, our topic title is 'Home Sweet Home'. In Science, we will be building upon our materials knowledge. In Geography, we will be looking at our local area. In Art, we will be looking at drawing skills and in PSHE we will be looking at our 'Changing Me' unit. In RE, we will be focusing on creation.
