Communication and Language

- Role play area – Tesco Shop
- Retell key texts using words & actions
- Key Worker Sessions - Show and Tell / News Time / Story time / Rhyme Time
- Key Language Concepts developed through key worker sessions – Understanding passive sentences, beginning to understand idioms, predicting what might happen, talking about things that are going to happen – future tense

Literacy

- ❖ Key Texts – Fiction: Animal Babies, A Day at Greenhill Farm, The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Lola Plants a Garden, Plant the Tiny Seed, From Tadpole to Frog.
- ❖ Create word bank linked to Spring and New Life and explore the meaning of new words
- ❖ Writing facts about spring
- ❖ Creating story map of The Very Hungry Caterpillar in chronological order
- ❖ Creating a non-fiction book about the life cycle of the frog
- ❖ Consistently using the golden rules for writing i.e capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- ❖ To be able to read simple sentences using phonic knowledge.
- ❖ Red Rose Phonics – Phase 3 - or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er.
- ❖ Tricky words – come, do, so, were, some, there, out, little, what
- ❖ Letter Formation – Consolidation of curly caterpillar letters – c a d g q o

- Subitising – to 6, including in structured arrangements
- Composition – ‘5 and a bit’
- Composition - of 10
- Comparison – linked to ordinality Play track
