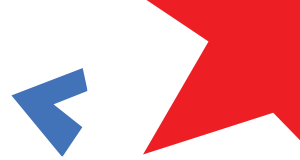

What we are studying



Maths

This half term in Maths we will be learning about decimals, money and time. We will also be continuing to develop our arithmetic skills daily.

We want to get those times tables and division facts conquered! We will continue to work on the trickier tables x6, x7, x8 and x9. The children need to have quick recall of all of their times tables by the end of year 4.

Early in Summer Term 2, your child will be taking the Multiplication Test Check. With this in mind, please continue to encourage your child to practice their times tables at home. It really does have an impact on their Maths learning and confidence when completing sound checks on TT Rockstars.

English

In English, we will be looking at the features of newspaper reports and writing our own newspaper reports about the Tudors. We will also look at performing poems using our Oracy skills performing 'The Sound Collector' by Roger McGough.

We will continue to learn new spelling rules. Please encourage your child to learn their weekly spellings thoroughly as it enables the children to write with fluency rather than struggling with spellings. Spelling assignments will be put on Spelling Shed weekly to support your child in the learning of their spellings. We will also continue to learn the grammar objectives for year 4, encouraging the children to use them in their writing.

Our class novel will be 'Tudor Tangle' by Steven Vinacour.

History

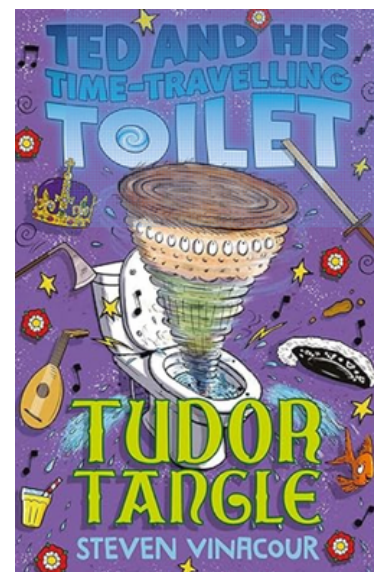
Our topic this term is called 'Terrible Tudors'. We will be learning all about Henry VIII and his wives and life in Tudor Times. Our learning will end with our trip to Turton Tower.

Key Vocabulary:

chronology, order, House of Lancaster, House of York, War of Roses, Tudor Rose, Battle of Bosworth, Henry III, reign, monarch, divorce

Our PSHE theme is 'relationships'.

In Art we will be exploring drawing skills.



Science

In Science, we will be continuing our topic of States of Matter during our Science lessons. We will investigate how some materials change state when they are heated or cooled. We will also look at the water cycle and discuss evaporation and condensation.

Key Vocabulary:

heated, cooled, temperature, degrees Celsius, water cycle
