To help my child at school, I will do my best to:

- Help my child to do his/her best;
- Make sure that my child arrives at school on time:
- Make sure my child wears suitable clothing in line with the school's code of dress including PE kit;
- Support my child with homework tasks and ensure homework is returned within the set time;
- Attend Parents' Evening and discuss progress with the teacher;

- Let the school know of any concerns that may affect my child's work or behaviour at school or ability to do homework;

- Foster a positive attitude towards education & the school & use discretion when discussing issues or grievances in front of children, as these may have a negative effect on their outlook;
- Use social media appropriately with respect to school, staff and school life;
- Follow the school's sickness and absence reporting policy and keep my child at home if they are unwell

- Read and act upon any information sent home, including the website and weekly newsletter in order that I can keep up-to-date with relevant information for my child

To help your child at school, we will do our best to:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child:
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility;
- Safeguard your child's safety and happiness. This will include taking positive action to tackle fallouts and bullying;
- Ensure that your child achieves her/his full potential as a valued member of the school community;
- Ensure that each classroom is a positive and stimulating learning environment.
- Set homework to extend the curriculum work in school;
- Teach children to develop a positive attitude towards everyone regardless of difference in gender, race, culture, belief, values, age, and need;
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved in the wider life of the school;
- Recognise effort and celebrate success;
- Provide an environment that is safe and has which has been risk assessed
- Communicate effectively and sensitively with parents through:
 - 1. Regular meetings to discuss the progress of children, indicating strengths and areas for development through individual targets.
 - 2. Providing prompt information about behaviour, punctuality, attendance, uniform or class work that may be a cause for concern or celebration.
 - 3. Providing clear information about homework tasks.
 - 4. Providing short training sessions on supporting children at home in specific curriculum areas.
 - 5. Providing opportunities for parents to become involved in school life.
 - 6. Providing information to parents about school activities through regular newsletters, open days, meetings and the annual report.
 - 7. Making available all relevant school policies, for information.
