What we are studying

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction and multiplication and division. We will be learning how to use a written method to support this, as well as considering the different mental methods that we can use to add or subtract.

To support at home, please work on number bonds to 10, 20 and 100, as well as doubling and halving numbers. We have learnt our 2, 5 and 10 times tables so far in Year 3 and we are moving on to learning our 4 times tables. Please ensure that your child is using TT Rockstars daily.



English

In English, we will be learning how to write explanation texts all about keeping healthy and poetry, specifically focusing on shape poems.

We will focus on different Year 3 grammar aspects such as prepositions, fronted adverbials and conjunctions.

We will continue to focus on developing our horizontal and diagonal joins when completing our handwriting and making sure all of our letters are formed correctly and joined up.



Geography

We will be learning all about our food and where it comes from and how it makes the journey.

We will also look at how UK farms differ from those in other countries.

This will include a trip to two local working farms to gain first-hand experience.

Science

We will be looking at identifying how animals including humans need a balanced diet and how food and nutrition affects them during our Science lessons.

Foundation subjects

- In DT, the children will be researching the ingredients used in smoothies and will create their own based on a design brief.
- They will be learning about the days of the week and months of the year in French.
- In R.E, we will be learning about how Jesus impacts people's lives and how Christmas is celebrated around the world.
- In music, we will be learning about ballads and learning Christmas carols for our Christmas concert.
- In PSHE, we will be learning about differences between ourselves and how we celebrate these.
