### Literacy

- ❖ Supplementary texts - Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus! London Bus, We can catch the bus, We Can't take an Elephant on the Bus, Naughty Bus, Mrs Armitage on Wheels.
- ❖ Create word bank linked to Transport and Our World and explore the meaning of new words.
- ❖ Retelling the story of selected texts- Talk 4writing.

### Mathematics

Pupils will:

- continue to develop their counting skills, counting larger sets as well as counting actions and sounds
- explore a range of representations of numbers, including the 10-frame, and see how doubles can be arranged in a 10-frame
- compare quantities and numbers, including sets of objects which have different attributes
- continue to develop a sense of magnitude, e.g. knowing that 8 is quite a lot more than 2, but 4 is only a little bit more than 2
- -begin to generalise about 'one more than'
