

Friendly Reminders

What we are studying

Maths

During our Maths lessons, we will be learning about fractions, decimals and percentages, measurement, properties of shape, position and direction and statistics. We will also be revising other topics that have been taught previously. Any help with learning fraction, decimal and percentage equivalences will be much appreciated.

English

In English, we will looking at how to write a Flashback Story and a fomral letter. We will also look at some genres which will contribute to the Writing element of SATs. We will be focusing on description, building tension, using dialogue to name a few. Children will still receive weekly spellings to learn which will be tested each Friday. In Reading, we will be continuing to work on our comprehension skills. Any reading you can do at home with your child will really help—they are still expected to read 5 times each week and have their reading diary signed.



Foundation Subjects

We continue studying World War Two this half term and hope to finish our novel Letters from the Lighthouse which the children are really enjoying. We will also begin learning about Eastern Europe in Geography. In Art, we will be leaning about 3D sculpture and finding out about the sculptor Henry Moore. In RE, the children will be studying the topic Who is Jesus which links to the Easter Story.

In PE, we will be learning about the importance of well-being through weekly yoga sessions and practising mindfulness techniques.

Our PSHE theme is 'Healthy Me' and we will look at healthy diets and drugs/medication.
