What we are studying

Maths

This half term we will be looking at length and perimeter, fractions, and decimals.

We will also be having daily mental maths activities to help improve our mental maths strategies.

The times table test will be in June. We will be focusing on learning our 6, 7 and 8 times tables this half term and then we will have covered all times tables! We will then continue to recap all of them daily. Please practice as much as you can at home.

English

In English, we will be learning how to write Viking Sagas. All the new Viking knowledge that the children will be learning throughout our Viking topic, will help them to create their own imaginative Viking Saga.


We will continue with our daily grammar and spelling lessons. Don't forget to use spelling shed to keep practising your spellings.

Our class novel this half term is 'There's a Viking in my bed' by Jeremy Strong.

History

This term, we are learning all about the 'Vicious Vikings'. We will be looking at who the Vikings were, where they came from, why the Vikings invaded Britain and how they lived.

Key Vocabulary: Viking raids, quest, Barbarian, longboat, Norseman, warrior, monastery, settlement, Danelaw, King Alfred, Jorvik, invade, settle, conquest, resistance, Trade, raid, loot, pillage, plunder



Science

In Science, our topic is 'States of Matter.' We will be grouping and classifying materials along with planning and carrying out investigations linked to solids, liquids and gases.

Key Vocabulary: Solid, liquid, gas, property, change, temperature, change state, heated, cooled, temperature, degrees Celsius, water cycle

For P.E, we will be covering yoga and tennis this half term and it is swimming for 4P

In DT we will be designing and making our own nightlights.

In PSHE we will be looking at how to keep healthy both physically and mentally.
