What we are studying

Maths

This half term we will be finishing off Maths with learning about time, statistics and position and direction. Any additional practice with telling the time will be beneficial to your child in order to support with this unit.

This half term, the children will be completing the Year 4 multiplication test. This will take place on the week beginning the 9th June.

Please encourage your child to practice the Sound Check on TTRockstars in preparation for this.

English

During our English this term, we will continue to develop the children's understanding of the Year 3/4 grammar objectives. We will recap on previously taught spelling rules and the year 3 and 4 common exception words. Please ensure your child learns their spellings each week and go back over any rules that they may have found tricky.

For Talk for Writing this half term we will be learning about explanation texts and adverts.

Geography

This term, our theme is based around our Geography unit which is our local area. In this topic we look at counties in the north of England, namely Lancashire and its immediate surroundings and the human and physical features of Lancashire and how they have changed over the years.

Key Vocabulary:

human features, physical features, landscape, city, county, compass points, North, South, East, West, immigration, population



Science

Our Science is linked to 'Marvellous Me' and we study the human digestive system. We learn the parts of the digestive system and what each one does. We will also learn about human teeth and what their functions are as well as learning about food chains.

Key Vocabulary:

digest, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, producer, predator, prey, oesophagus, mouth, stomach
