

# What we are studying

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## Maths

In our maths lessons this half term, we will be working on fractions, decimals and percentages. Within this unit, we will cover all of the Year 5 objectives whilst also revising over work covered in previous years. Any extra help at home with this will be greatly appreciated. 
## English

In English, we will be reading a variety of non-chronological texts and eventually writing our own. In SPAG, we will continue to focus on new spelling rules and the Year 5 grammar objectives. We will be applying these rules in our writing. Please continue to practice spellings at home with your child



## Geography

This half term, we are very excited to really get stuck into our learning of 'All around the World' We will learn about the major lines of latitude and longitude, where they are on the globe and how they are significant to our lives.



## Science

In science we will be looking at human development from a foetus through to birth and beyond. We will create timelines of the changes and look at similarities and differences between the stages of growth. We will also look at the changes that occur during puberty which is always a lively lesson!



## Art

Our new planning for art will look at the work of the British artist Yinka Ilori who uses bold and vibrant colours and repeating patterns to create dynamic compositions. Children will work to recreate their own pieces in the style of his work.



## French

This term we will be learning Qu'est-ce que vous portez? – What are you wearing? We will be learning the masculine and feminine nouns of a variety of clothing and using the new phrases in conversation.
